BMC meetings are the last Monday of every month. Any items/requests to be added to the agenda must be submitted to the principal or chairman by the Monday prior to each meeting. Any items that are submitted after the Monday deadline may be tabled until the following months BMC meeting. Thank you.

**Our school building** has had several more cases of "fifth disease." Fifth disease is a mild rash that occurs commonly in children. The child typically has a "slapped cheek" rash on the face and a lacy red rash on the trunk and limbs. Occasionally the rash may itch. An ill child may have a low-grade fever, malaise, or a 'cold' a few days before the rash breaks out. The child is usually not very ill, and the rash resolves in 7-10 days. A person infected with fifth disease is contagious during the early part of the illness, before the rash appears. By the time the 'slapped cheek' rash occurs for example, the child is no longer contagious! A susceptible person usually becomes ill 4-14 days after being infected with the virus, but may become ill for as long as 20 days after infection.

**Important change and request!** It has been brought to our attention that the state of Wisconsin prohibits copying of all vital records. That means we cannot accept photocopied birth certificates of your child. We also will not accept baptismal certificates as proof of birth. As enrollment approaches for next school year, please take the time to locate your child's original birth certificate. If you do not have one, you will need to take care of this. We require all original birth certificates to be presented at time of enrollment. I realize they are expensive. We do not need to keep them. A form will be filled out in your presence and the original certificate will be returned to you.

Parents, please help us update all student folders. All public school districts are required to make these changes, we would like to follow accordingly! If anyone has their child's birth certificate available now and would like to update their file, you are welcome to come in and take care of this matter.
